"A Challenge to the Rising Generation"

"And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year." The basic motif of this Biblical command is the call for a revival of the old as a means of sanctifying the new. It has always been a basic characteristic of Judaism that guidance and wisdom are sought out of past experience. Memory is searched and searched again, and not out of pure sentimentality.



RABBI RUDOLPHE WEISS

A distinguished Jewish philosopher and essayist, known in Jewish literature by his pen name, Ahad Haam, defined in one of his writing the difference between those who search the past for wisdom and those who merely retreat to past trails and achievements as a refuge from reality. In an essay titled "Past and Future," he wrote that those of us who gravitate in thinking only toward the past become old in spirit as well as years. Such a backward viewpoint indicates an inner decadence. To remain both young and vital, it is necessary to think and act by the

needs of the future. We must be captured by challenging dreams and noble ideals, and this is true of the life of an individual as well as in the history of a congregation.

It behooves us all to reflect upon the splendid achievements which are culminated now by this Golden Jubilee celebration. We in Carnegie, this fine small community, have reason to be particularly proud of the credit side of our ledger. Fifty years ago, a small group, most of whom were struggling immigrants, devout Jews who brought with them a precious heritage of faith and tradition from their homelands, all yearning for freedom and love, erected in their midst a house of worship and founded our Congregation. This they named Ahavath Achim, meaning Brotherly Love.

Two of our Charter members, still with us by the mercy and grace of God, Mr. Markus Sherman and Mr. Jacob Speiser, can well testify to the hardships and obstacles which surround the creation of our Congregation. Since that time, fifty years, under the direction of a series of able presidents, through the spiritual leadership of my distinguished predecessors and through the sacrificial efforts of many devoted members, this house of worship has brought to fruition the dreams and ideals of its noble and pious founders. For, in truth, this House has grown into a home for our community; a home too, out of which much activity and inspiration springs. For a Congregation of our size we have magnified our scope until it well approaches that of our larger, wealthier colleagues. Our Congregation is the core out of which has grown a well organized Sisterhood, B'nai B'rith, Hadassah, Z.O.A. Young Judeans, and such integral parts as a cheder and Sunday School—al efficient and progressive with remarkable records of achievements. But above all this, our Congregation has remained loyal and faithful to the noble ideals for which it was named. We have maintained peace and harmony, true brotherhood not only among our own members, but we have created such an aura between ourselves and countless members of other creeds.

And yet, with this fine record, we must still be mindful of our future problems, which must constitute the debit side of our ledger. Specifically I refer to the challenge of the rising generation. It is an imperative duty that all of us prod our youth onward in meeting that challenge. It is a challenge, which, if not met, could easily jeopardize the very existence and survival of our congregation. We must seek every means to arouse sufficient interest on the part of our young people in the religious activities of this Congregation.

At present, most of our people in this congregation retain an inner identification with genuine Judaism and simultaneously with our community; but other such small communities have experienced a tragic breaking-away on the part of younger people—the resultant spiritual chaos, the drift from tradition and heritage

Half a Century in Carnegie

After fifty years of religious distinction, the Congregation Ahavath Achim of Carnegie proudly exhibits its glorious past and progressively looks to the future with optimism.

It was in the month of May 1898 that Markus Sherman called a meeting in his home for the purpose of activating a congregation. Eleven men were present and of these eleven men Markus Sherman was elected President and Joseph Hirsh, Secretary.

Services had been held as early as 1896 in Markus Sherman's home, with High Holiday services in Husler's Hall, Carnegie, Pa. In 1901 services were held in the Martin Building.

In 1903, the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County incorporated the Congregation Ahavath Achim for the purposes of worshipping the Almighty God according to the faith, doctrines and usages of the Orthodox Jewish Church. At this time Falk Kantor was President and Markus Sherman was secretary. Jacob Speizer, also a charter member, had been very active since the origin of the Congregation.

After incorporation, the Congregation established itself in the community by purchasing a property at 204 Broadway, Carnegie, Pa. After alterations and additions, the frame building on this property became the permanent home and Synagogue for the Congregation until a fire completely destroyed the entire structure on December 15, 1934.

From 1934 until September 1937 services and other activities were held in the Moose Temple Building, Chartiers Street. At the regular meeting of the Congregation during the month of April 1935, President Aron Mayer appointed a committee to purchase a site for the erection of the new Synagogue. This committee, consisting of Ben E. Sherman and Harry Suttin, selected the present site on the corner of Chestnut and Lydia Streets. The Jewish Mother's Club, now known as the Sisterhood, after many fund raising affairs, contributed a great deal toward the purchase of this lot. In the month of May, 1937, the Building Committee, consisting of President Max Pretter, Chairman, David Raskin, Ben E. Sherman, Eli Moskovitz and Harry Zemon, were authorized to award the contract for the construction of the new Synagogue. Ground was broken early in June 1937 with the Corner Stone laying ceremony being held June 27, 1937. The

first High Holiday services were held in the new Synagogue on September 6, 1937 even though the building was not entirely completed. The furnishings were installed on December 1, 1937 and the official dedication and banquet was held on December 5, 1937. Mr. Charles Perilman was Chairman of this important function.

Since 1937 the Congregation has prospered with the assistance of the Sisterhood and the interest manifested by the younger men of the community. In 1944, under the Presidency of Morris Wilk, an epic event in the community was the official burning of the Mortgage. In the past few years more English services have been included in the Holiday services so that everyone may participate in these services. A Memorial Plaque, under the Chairmanship of Ben Nord, has been permanently affixed on the wall in the Synagogue to memorialize our departed loved ones. A permanent Plaque on the opposite wall lists the names of 62 men and women from the Congregation who served in the Armed Forces of the United States during World War II. At the present time the Congregation has sixty-five members.

These facts appear cold because they are statistical in nature but they become alive when the personalities of the men and women who made all this possible are injected into their corresponding niches of time and events.

In 1948 Rabbi Rudolphe Weiss was welcomed to our community, and is our present religious leader. Rabbi Weiss is beloved by everyone because of his noble and tireless efforts in guiding us spiritually, teaching our children, counseling our sick and needy and representing our Congregation among our gentile friends and neighbors. Some of our previous Rabbis were Simon Helfgott, Samuel Mallinger, H. Feirstein, Jacob Perilman, N. Cohen, Rabbi Bachrach, Rabbi Liftman and others.

This Congregation may justly be proud of its leadership during the past fifty years. Our capable Presidents of the past are truly represented by our fine President of the past 9 years. Morris Wilk has been the key to our progress and success in recent years. Under his capable leadership and because of his pleasant personality and untiring efforts we have prospered in every way. We are greatly indebted to previous Presidents who contributed more than their share toward our glorious past. These Presidents include Noah Buchman, Max Pretter, Ben E. Sherman, Aron

Mayer, Falk Kantor, Harry Suttin, Ben Turk, Joseph Hirsh, Louis Meyers, Markus Sherman, Morris Chairmovitz, Jacob Eger, and others.

As Treasurer, this Congregation is fortunate in having a man who has always been a pillar of strength in the Congregation. For 47 years, Isaac Peresman has very capable assumed full responsibility for our treasury.

Some of our hard working Secretaries have included Stanley Roth, who has been our Secretary for the past 6 years, Sol Zions, Louis Wilk, Phillip Perlman and Hyman Lipman who served notably for many years in various other capacities as well as Secretary.

In addition to the names already given, there are many outstanding men who gave their strength and their heart to every cause. These include Harry Levine, Saul Moskovitz, William Weiss, Joseph Weisband, Charles Perilman, Sam Moskovitz, Joseph Wilk, Joseph Hirsh, Phillip Perlman, Joseph York, David Raskin, Isaac Weishasky, Harry Zemon, Harry Burnkrant, Sam Klee, Jacob York, Meyer Bales, and many others.

Behind every venture in years past, sharing all of the hard work but with little credit were many of our mothers. Some of these women who were very active were Mrs. Joseph Stern, Mrs. Max Roth, Mrs. Phillip Perlman, Mrs. Sam Perlman, Mrs. Max Miller, Mrs. David Raskin, Mrs. Max Pretter, Mrs. Harry Levine, Mrs. Charles Perlman, Mrs. Joseph Wilk, Mrs. Isaac Peresman, Mrs. Sam Markovitz, Mrs. Joseph Hirsh, Mrs. Katie Klee, and many others.

All organizations affiliated with the Congregation during the past 50 years have earned their place in this history. These include the Community Circle, Lears Club, G. A. Y. Sorority, Juda Club, Jewish Mothers Club, A.Z.A., Clevis Club, C.J.J.C., and of more recent vintage, we have the Carnegie Jewish Sisterhood, Hadassah, B'nai B'rith Lodge and the Young Judea Club.

A history is never concluded for we live for the future and we build for tomorrow, so that our children will find their place in posterity. In this sense, we dedicate this history to our children with the blessings of fifty fruitful years in the past, and the prayer that they may say "Amen" at the Centennial Anniversary of the Ahavath Achim Congregation.

This can be done without surrendering any of our customs or traditions. With a feeling of importance and responsibility we can take young people closer to the tenets of our Torah.

Here in Carnegie we may be optimistic about the future, for ours is a community enriched with youngsters. By adequate planning for both our Cheder and Sunday School we can take advantage of such youth, guarantee to the survival of our heritage and the spiritual strength of our congregation.

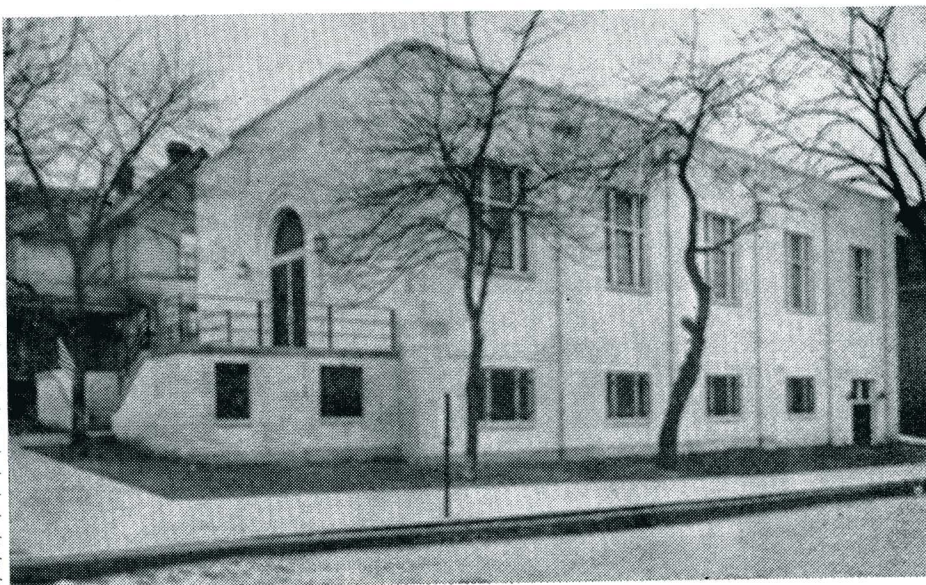

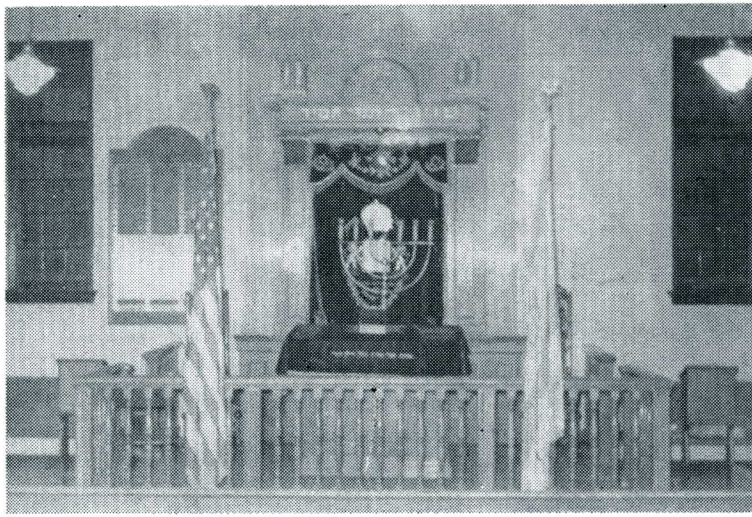
